The Yellow strip in our Corps Colours is in recognition of the yellow coats worn by the Duke of Albany's Regiment.

The Red strip denotes our Royal Marine Artillery.

The Green denotes our Royal Marine Light Infantry.

The Blue denotes our Royal Navy connection.
